



Renault Sport Enthusiast Days – Regulations

1 - Registration

The maximum number of participants at each Renault Sport Enthusiast Days is variable.

Participants are requested to refer to the documentation concerning individual Renault Sport Enthusiast Days to find out how many places are available.

Entries must be submitted by post, duly completed and accompanied by a cheque for the full registration fee or a bank transfer for abroad and by the duly documented Responsibility Waiver document for Track Days. All entries falling to meet these conditions will be returned to the sender. Registration forms for any companion/simple passengers who are under the age of sixteen must be signed by the child's parent/guardian (See document Parental Consent).

The organiser reserves the right to refuse entries at its discretion from all persons who fail to observe these regulations or who have driven in a dangerous manner or who have contravened instructions given at a previous Renault Sport Enthusiast Day.

Entries received after the closing date will not be considered unless they comply in full with the conditions in the preceding paragraphs and if that it is reasonable for the organiser to consider them despite their late arrival.

All cheques sent with entries will be banked on the date of the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question.

2 - Cancellation

Entrants have the right to cancel entries if they inform the organiser by post or electronically (journees.passion@renault.com) before the specified closing date for the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question. The cheque supplied with the entry form will then be returned to the address given on the entry form.

The organiser reserves the right to cancel any Renault Sport Enthusiast Day up to the closing date for entries. Registered entrants will be informed as soon as possible and at the latest by the date specified in the documentation for the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question.

Furthermore, the organisers reserve the right to cancel any Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in the event of circumstances beyond the organiser's control.

In the event of cancellation, for whatever reason, the organiser will return the cheques that accompany entry forms to duly registered persons without delay.

3 – Vehicles

When the programme of Renault Sport Enthusiast Days involves participants using their own cars at Renault Sport Enthusiast Days (circuit driving, touring etc.), these vehicles must comply with the following conditions:

- they must comply with traffic laws, notably with regard to noise,
- they must be in good mechanical order,
- they must be equipped with roadworthy tyres (all competition tyres, both slicks and wets, are forbidden),
- they must be presented with legal paperwork (logbook in the name of the entrant or a written statement from the owner authorising the entrant to use the car in the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question),
- they must be insured,
- they must have a valid roadworthiness certificate if required (e.g., MOT certificate for British registered cars).

The organiser reserves the right to ensure compliance with these conditions at any point during Renault Sport Enthusiast Days, in particular concerning the presence of a logbook in the entrants name or a written statement from the owner authorising the entrant to use the car in the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question, roadworthiness certificate and up to date insurance.

Any entrant whose vehicle falls to comply with all these terms or who refuses to comply with the organiser's checks may be refused permission to take part or may be excluded, immediately and at any point, without any right to reimbursement of his entry fee in whole or in part.

The presence of a vehicle on the track does not, of itself, constitute acknowledgement, implicit or otherwise, by the organizers of its compliance with the conditions defined in this article. There should be no mobile equipment inside the cabin.

4 - Driving licences

All entrants who drive in the course of a Renault Sport Enthusiast Day, no matter what the vehicle, must possess a valid driving licence (equivalent to the French Type B licence) unless the documentation for the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question specifically states that this condition does not apply. The organiser reserves the right to demand its presentation at any moment.

Any entrant who fails to produce a driving licence may be refused permission to take part or may be excluded, immediately and at any point, without having any right to reimbursement of his entry fee in whole or in part.

5 - Clothing

While driving on a circuit in the vehicle of a participant, drivers and passengers must wear crash helmets, it is recommended that suitable sports clothing is worn.

6 – Safety

Renault Sport Enthusiast Days are and must remain social occasions during which entrants enjoy themselves in complete safety. They are not a form of competition.

The following rules must be strictly observed by all entrants when driving at Renault Sport Enthusiast Days:

- attendance at the briefing is compulsory for all entrants,
- entrants must obey the organiser's instructions at all times,
- driving dangerously or in breach of instructions may lead to immediate exclusion from the Renault Sport Enthusiast Day in question, without any right to reimbursement of the entry fee in whole or in part. The organiser will at his discretion reserve the right to refuse all entries from persons who have not respected the rules, or have driven dangerously, or disobeyed instructions during previous Renault Sport Enthusiast Days.

On public roads:

- strict adherence to traffic laws.

On circuits:

- seatbelts are compulsory,
- there should be no more than two people per vehicle,
- flag signals must be obeyed,
- overtaking must be on straights,
- slower vehicles must allow faster vehicles to overtake; the faster vehicle must wait until the slower vehicle pulls over,
- vehicles must keep 40 meters apart,
- driving in the opposite direction or reversing is forbidden,
- it is forbidden to stop on the track, or in acceleration or deceleration lanes,
- front windows must be closed,
- the speed limit in the pits and paddock is 30 kph.

The organiser may temporarily halt or curtail any Renault Sport Enthusiast Day on safety grounds, without conferring any right to reimbursement of entry fees in whole or in part.

7 - Responsibilities

Entrants should be aware of the risks of high-speed driving on a circuit, even in conditions of optimum safety. Neither the organiser nor its partners nor its agents can be held responsible for any injury or material loss sustained during Renault Sport Enthusiast Days.

Consequently, in their own names and those of their dependents and those to whom they have any obligations, entrants renounce the right to any action against the organiser, its partners, its agents or its insurers for any injury or material loss sustained during Renault Sport Enthusiast Days.

On this account, they accept to complete on request by the organiser the sample disclaimer downloadable from www.renault-sport.com.

8 - Insurance

Before access to the circuit with their vehicle, entrants must check beforehand that their insurance covers this type of activity. If it does not, it is essential that they arrange an extension to their cover.

9 – Deposit

At Renault Sport Enthusiast Days on circuits (driving tuitions or track days) it may be required that each driver leaves a cheque with the organiser as a deposit in advance. This will be mentioned in the documentation for the Renault Sport Enthusiast Days concerned and the following rules apply should an entrant damage other vehicles and/or equipment belonging to the driving school or the circuit:

- If damage assessed by the driving school or the circuit amounts to the deposit or more, the entire deposit will be kept by the driving school or the circuit. No additional deposit will be demanded of the entrant.
- If damage assessed by the driving school or circuit amounts to less than the deposit, only the amount corresponding to the damage will be due from the entrant.

10 - Venue access

For safety reasons, access to venues hosting Renault Sport Enthusiast Days may be refused to all persons who have not entered the event in question.

Children under 16 and animals, even if on a lead, may not be granted access to all or part of any venues hosting Renault Sport Enthusiast Days. Consult www.renault-sport.com in advance for information.

11 – Regulations

Regulations applying to individual venues hosting Renault Sport Enthusiast Days will apply. It is the entrant's responsibility to familiarize himself with them before any Renault Sport Enthusiast Day for which he registers.

The organiser reserves the right to amend these regulations at any time.

Making an entry implies the final and unqualified acceptance of these regulations.

12 - Photos and communications

Photography (either camera or video) is forbidden within the Renault plants without the express permission of the organiser, given in advance.

Entrants accept that the organiser will take photographs of the entrants and their vehicles at Renault Sport Enthusiast Days and may publish them through the www.renault-sport.com site or in documents relating to Renault Sport Enthusiast Days, in any format and for any purpose. Photographs depicting vehicle registration plates are permitted.

13 – Challenge

All entrants accept to participate in the 2008 Renault Sport Enthusiast Days Passion Challenge and accept the regulations of this challenge as well as the publication of all or any of the temporary or definitive classification of this challenge (with mention of names, first names, points acquired and - in case of ex aequo - age of the participants) through the www.renault-sport.com site or in documents relating to Renault Sport Enthusiast Days, in any format and for any purpose.

14 – Fuel

Fuel will not be provided during Renault Sport Enthusiast Days. It is the entrants' responsibility to make use of filling stations of their choice as necessary.

15 – Parking

Cars must be parked as directed by the organiser during Renault Sport Enthusiast Days.
